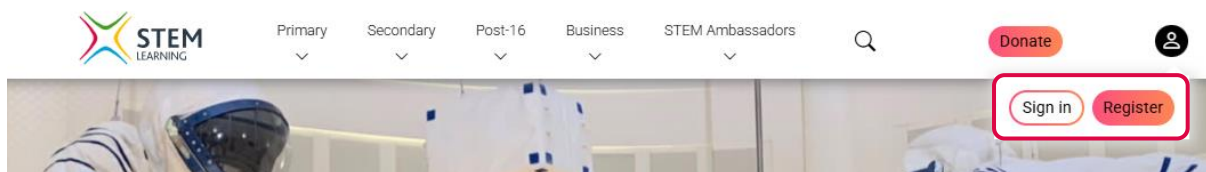

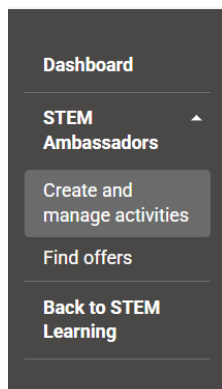
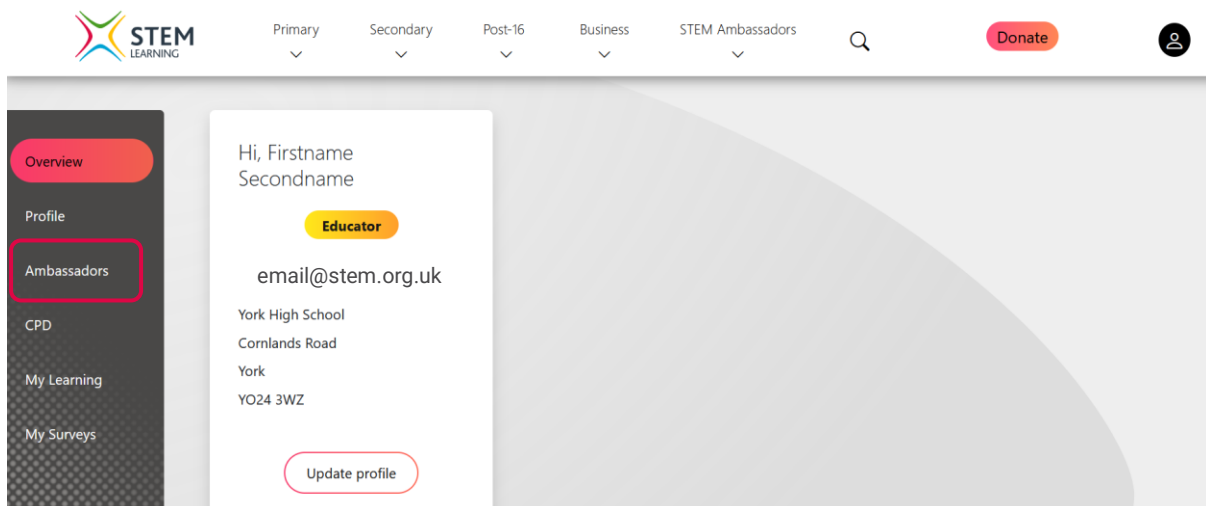
Browsing activities offered by STEM Ambassadors

You will need an educator or youth group leader account with us at www.stem.org.uk. Select the black icon in the top right and 'register' to create your account or sign in if you already have an account.



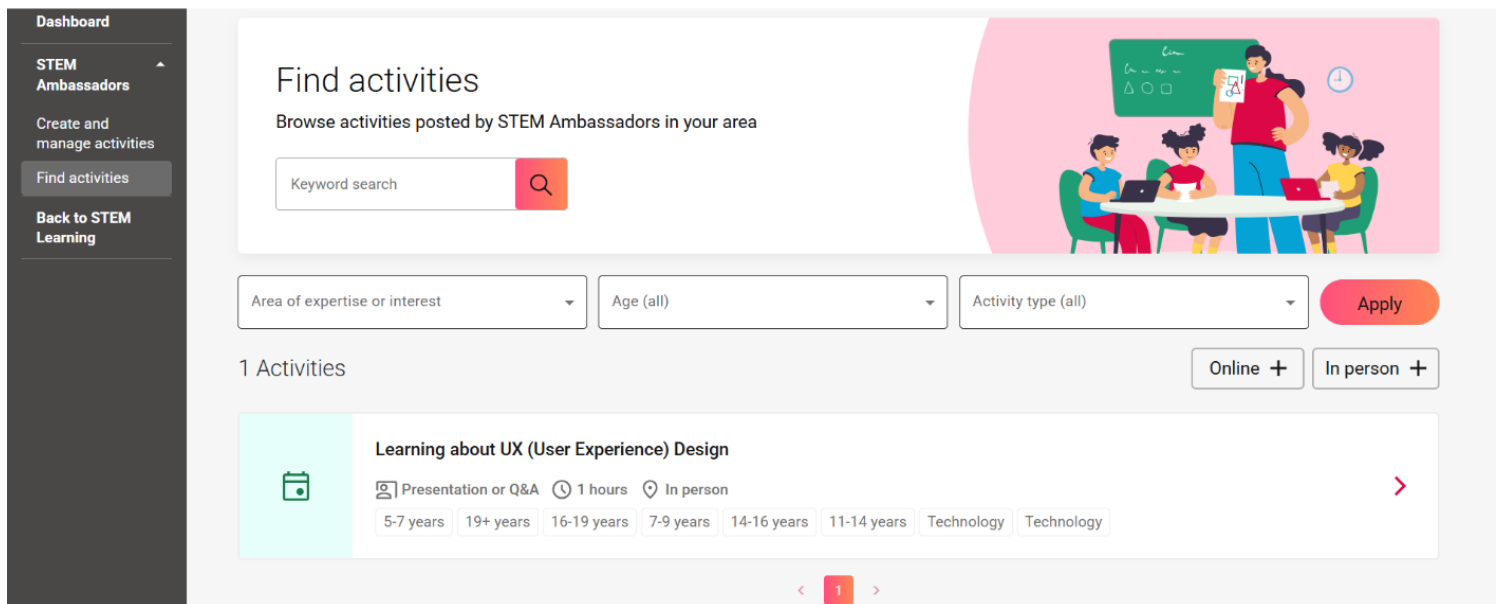
You will come to a page that looks like this. Please click Ambassadors on the left-hand side to be brought to the STEM Ambassadors platform.



Once you are logged in to the STEM Ambassador platform, go to the menu bar on the left-hand side and click 'Find offers'.

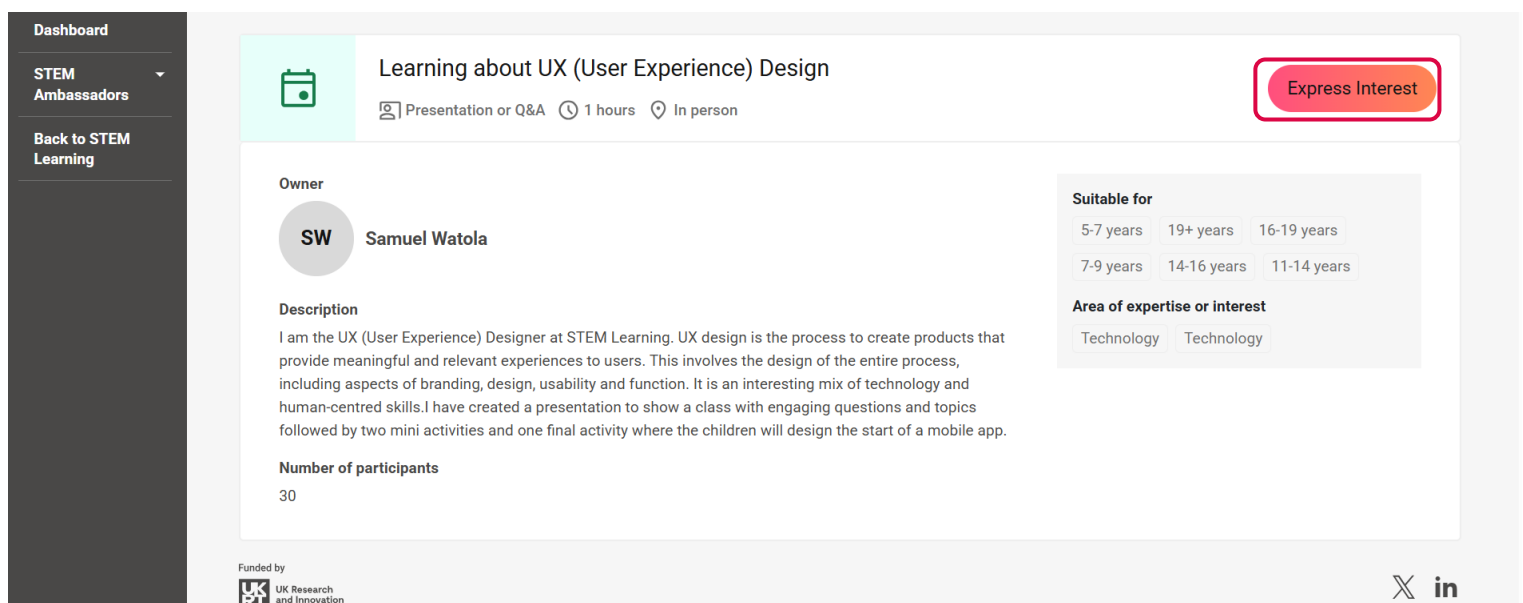

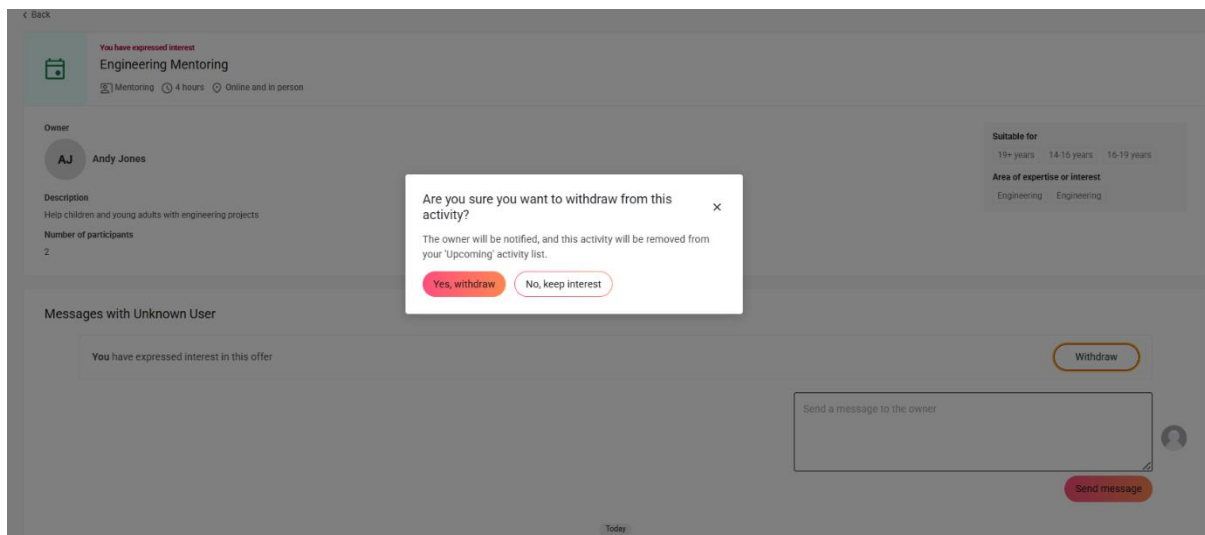

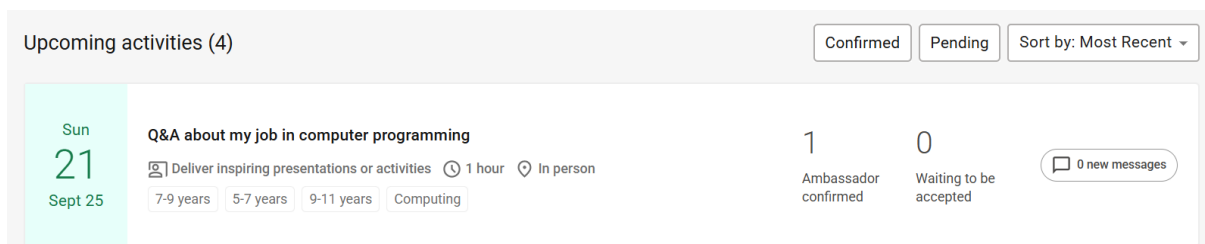

Guidelines for working well with STEM Ambassadors
